## Peter's teaching

Radiant Mind is Peter's current teaching and the fruit of his experiences. His personal journey and interactions with many teachers over the world culminated in this synthesis of several Asian spiritual traditions presented in a format easily grasped by westerners.

Far from the habitual acquisition of new information, it consists of a clearing process by which one is invited to explore the nature of mental constructs so that they can be "seen through." This process of observation brings to light the illusory nature of our beliefs and intellectual and emotional fixations, thus allowing them to dissolve. It is a very immediate and practical process in the form of incisive questions and dialogues – sometimes disconcerting ones - during which the mind is confronted with its own limits.

These meetings with Peter invite one to explore an inner space, a transparent presence, a natural silence and a deep joy free of any object. The mind becomes silent, and one is left simply present to what arises in the moment.

**\* Please note that in Geneva the dialogues take place in English with French translation.**

## About Peter Fenner

For nine years, Peter Fenner was a Buddhist monk, receiving initiations from many Tibetan Masters including his Holiness the Dalai Lama, Lama Thubten Yeshe, Lama Sogyal Rinpoche and Chögyal Namkhai Norbu. He holds a doctorate in philosophy and has taught Buddhism in various international universities and institutes for more than 30 years.

Peter's books include **Radiant Mind - Awakening the Unconditioned Awareness** (Sounds True, 2007), **The Ontology of the Middle Way** (Kluwer, 1990), **Reasoning into Reality** (Wisdom Publications, 1994), **Essential Wisdom Teachings** (with Penny Fenner, Nicolas-Hays, 2001), **The Edge of Certainty: Paradoxes on the Buddhist Path** (Nicolas-Hays, 2002), and **Sacred Mirror: Nondual Wisdom and Psychotherapy** (Editor, Omega Books, 2003).

His psychological essays have appeared in journals such as the *Journal of Contemplative Psychotherapy*, *Revision*, *Journal of the International Association for Spiritual Psychiatry*, *Psychologia* (Tokyo), and *3<sup>e</sup> millenaire*.

Sunday, **December 11<sup>th</sup>** from 9 am to 4 pm.
- A bed in a double room on site with breakfast included.
